Chairman's Report

Welcome to the 56th annual report to the California Rice Growers. In this year's report, we will update you on grower funded research from the various 2024 projects. Some of the most prominent projects that were funded include the ongoing rice breeding program at the Rice Experiment Station, statewide variety trials, weed and disease management including weedy red rice, cover crop studies, invertebrate pest management and practices, as well as several others.

The 2024 season saw a shorter than normal crop in planted acres, and yields were below average on the early and late planted rice acres, but the middle planting dates which make up 70% of the acres planted were above normal. The Rice Research Board was able to fund a full slate of projects for the 2024 crop year. We are hopeful that with the rainfall and snowpack from this winter's storms that planting will continue to stay in the 500,000-acre range, and as of this writing it looks like the crop size will increase over last year's crop which was 465,000 to around 510,000. It seems every year is different with the weather seemingly dictating what acreage we are planting.



Let's hope for a rebound in paddy rice prices for the 2025 crop as 2024 crop has been very disappointing to say the least, as expenses still seem to be on the rise.
